- Consult with our employees on matters affecting Health, Safety & Welfare.
- Provide & maintain safe plant & equipment.
- Ensure safe handling and use of substances.
- Provide training information, instruction & supervision for employees.
- Ensure all employees are competent to carry out their tasks and to give them adequate training.
- Prevent accidents, injury and cases of work related ill health; maintain safe and health working conditions.
- Periodically review & revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals.
- Continual improvement in occupational health & safety management and performance.
- Comply with all matters relating to the current Covid-19 Pandemic.

The Managing Director has ultimate responsibility for Occupational Health & Safety within the company, of which the day to day management is delegated to the senior management team.
